

Notice to City of Cape May Water Customers...

All water mains serving the City of Cape May will be “flushed” to remove build up of rust and sediment in the pipes, thereby improving water quality, between Monday, Oct 15 & Tuesday, Oct 30, 7a.m. to 4p.m. as shown below.

While flushing does not cut off the supply of water, it does “stir up” rust.

Customers should draw water for essential use before flushing in your area.

2012 Water Main Flushing Schedule

Oct 15– Oct 30

1. Mon, & Tues Oct 15 & 16: West of Perry St.
2. Wednesday, Oct 17: North of Mall, Perry to Jefferson
3. Thurs & Fri, Oct 18 & 19: South of Mall Perry to Jefferson


4. Mon & Tues, Oct 22 & Oct 23
Jefferson to Madison

5. Wednesday, Oct 24:
North of Michigan, Indiana
And Massachusetts Aves.

6. Thurs & Fri, Oct 25 & 26: North of Cape May Avenue

7. Mon & Tues, Oct 29 & Oct 30: South of Cape May Avenue
